

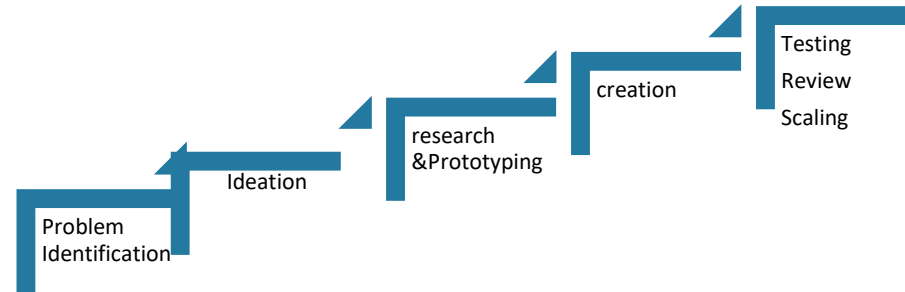

### What can you report?

#### EMOTIONAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL VIOLENCE

- Prevent you from being in education or employment
- Humiliating you in front of others
- Threatening to hurt you, people you care about, or pets
- Deciding things for you that you should decide, like what you wear or eat
- Acting jealous, including constantly accusing you of cheating
- Making your needs or feelings seem unimportant or less important than those of the abuser. Etc.

#### ECONOMIC VIOLENCE

- Prevent you from being in education or employment
- Limit your working hours
- Take your pay
- Refuse to let you claim benefits
- Refuse to let you access a bank account
- Steal your money or property
- Cause damage to your property
- Build up debt in your name, sometimes without your knowledge

#### PHYSICAL VIOLENCE

- Scratching or biting
- Pushing or shoving
- Slapping
- Kicking
- Choking or strangling
- Throwing things
- Forced feeding or Food denial
- Using weapons harmful objects

#### SEXUAL VIOLENCE

- Defilement
- Rape
- Sexual assault
- Intimate sexual violence
- Incest
- Stalking
